All entries made on this form are correct at the time of entry. Any changes must be notified and agreed with the Organisers beforehand. This entry covers the boat named only. No refunds will be made for cancellation or non-attendance.

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.

Third party insurance to an indemnity minimum of £1,000,000 (one million pounds) must be held.

A current British Waterway Licence must be displayed.

Toilets must not be discharged into the waterway.

You must abide by the directions of any officers at the event appointed by the Organisers and with health & safety and similarly applicable regulations.

The Organisers cannot be held responsible for any damage to persons or property, however caused. The Organisers ruling on all matters is final.

Moorings are at the absolute discretion of the Organisers and may be changed at any time. The Organisers reserve the right to move any boat from the moorings prior to and/or during the rally should the need arise.

Information on this form may in whole or part be recorded in a computer in accordance with current data protection legislation. All data recorded under your name may be inspected on application to the entries manager.

The Organisers warn all attendees of the dangers of Weil's Disease and other water-borne infections but cannot be held responsible should any disease be contracted whilst attending or travelling to or from the event.
